Sailing Instructions for 2021

| Course 1 | Wind Range | 67.5 - 112.5 |
|----------|------------|---------------|
| Course 2 | Wind Range | 112.5 - 157.5 |
| Course 3 | Wind Range | 157.5 - 202.5 |
| Course 4 | Wind Range | 202.5 - 247.5 |
| Course 5 | Wind Range | 247.5 - 292.5 |
| Course 6 | Wind Range | 292.5 - 337.5 |
| Course 7 | Wind Range | 337.5 - 22.5 |
| Course 8 | Wind Range | 22.5 - 67.5 |

As you see, the selection of the course for the evening is based on a wind direction half way between the wind direction for the course on either side of the one chosen.

For example, Course 3 - 180 degrees, would be the choice for wind directions between 157.5 and 202.5 degrees.

If the wind is STEADY at either of the extremes (157.5 degrees or 202.5 degrees) you could also select course 2 or course 4 respectively. 157.5 degrees being the overlap between course 2 and 3 and 202.5 degrees being the overlap between course 3 and 4.

If the wind is SHIFTING at either of the extremes, select the course in the direction of the shift. For example, if the wind is at 157.5 degrees and the direction is DECREASING, choose course 2. Alternatively if the wind is at 202.5 degrees and the direction is INCREASING, choose course 4.
